Biden has signed the bill into law! Our thanks to Citizens for Alternatives to Animal Research and Experimentation for spearheading the letter. Fish Feel has also endorsed the Plant Based Treaty, and is a Policy Leader with Animal Place's Food for Thought program.

Media

Every day, we search news and other sources for information about fishes. In response to many articles, we post comments advocating for fishes, and we share the most relevant information on our Facebook page and on other pages. Some of our comments are also quoted by the media, such as one in response to an article about wildlife killing contests, which was published as a letter in a subsequent issue, and this one against hypocrisy in the fishing industry.

Please make a point of advocating for fishes whenever you get a chance to do so. They desperately need your help!

Fish Feel was also mentioned recently in The Animal Doctor's syndicated column, and Mary and veterinarian Michael W. Fox submitted a letter to the Star Tribune (MN) cautioning against shrimp farming and the consumption of shrimps or shrimp byproducts.

We are delighted that animal rights activist and filmmaker Ryuji Chua was a guest on The Daily Show to discuss his terrific video advocating for fishes.

Elsewhere in the media, the new film, Blueback, "focuses on a friendship with a big friendly fish ... and the powerful response to humans threatening the animal." Now in cinemas around Australia, hopefully Blueback will be available to a global audience soon. The blockbuster, Avatar: The Way of Water, with its strong pro-environmental theme, is receiving critical acclaim.
